Due to expected road closures and traffic restrictions, we believe it will NOT be possible to march in both parades. Please pick either Lexington or Concord.

5:30 AM at Lexington: Battle reenactment on the Battle Green.

8:30 AM at Concord: Parade in Concord with the Deputy Grand Master.

- Arrive by 7:45 am. The Concord parade starts at Thoreau St. / Laurel St.
 3.5 mile route to Worthen St. / Massachusetts Ave.
- All Masons parading with the Grand Lodge should wear a **Rev250 Apron** (order from the G.L. Supply Office online via MassMasons.org). No pocket jewels (risk of loss/theft). Lodge officer collars may be worn.
- Following the parade, lunch will be available for purchase at the Concord Masonic Building (Corinthian Lodge), located on Monument Square.
- There will be several events around Concord that Brethren are encouraged to enjoy with their families. See https://visitconcord.org/event/patriots-day-activities-for-concord-250/

2:00 PM at Lexington: Parade in Lexington with the Grand Master.

- Arrive by 1:15 pm. The Lexington parade starts at Maple St. / Massachusetts Ave. near the Scottish Rite National Heritage Museum. 1.85 mile route to Worthen St. / Massachusetts Ave.
- All Masons parading with the Grand Lodge should wear a Rev250 Apron (order from the G.L. Supply Office
 online via MassMasons.org). No pocket jewels (risk of loss/theft). Lodge officer collars may be worn.
- There will be several events around Lexington that Brethren are encouraged to enjoy with their families. See https://lex250.org/
