**5:30 AM at Lexington: Battle reenactment on the Battle Green.**

**8:30 AM at Concord: Parade in Concord with the Deputy Grand Master.**

- Arrive by 7:45 am. The Concord parade starts at Thoreau St. / Laurel St. 3.5 mile route to Worthen St. / Massachusetts Ave.
- All Masons parading with the Grand Lodge should wear a **Rev250 Apron** (order from the G.L. Supply Office online via [MassMasons.org](https://MassMasons.org)). No pocket jewels (risk of loss/theft). Lodge officer collars may be worn.
- Following the parade, lunch will be available for purchase at the Concord Masonic Building (Corinthian Lodge), located on Monument Square.
- There will be several events around Concord that Brethren are encouraged to enjoy with their families.

**2:00 PM at Lexington: Parade in Lexington with the Grand Master.**

- Arrive by 1:15 pm. The Lexington parade starts at Maple St. / Massachusetts Ave. near the Scottish Rite National Heritage Museum. 1.85 mile route to Worthen St. / Massachusetts Ave.
- All Masons parading with the Grand Lodge should wear a **Rev250 Apron** (order from the G.L. Supply Office online via [MassMasons.org](https://MassMasons.org)). No pocket jewels (risk of loss/theft). Lodge officer collars may be worn.
- There will be several events around Lexington that Brethren are encouraged to enjoy with their families.
